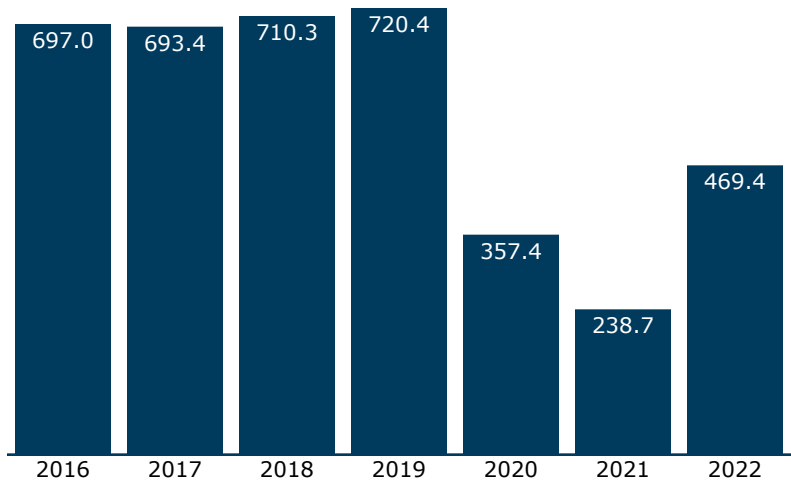


Fact sheet: Amtrak in Delaware
