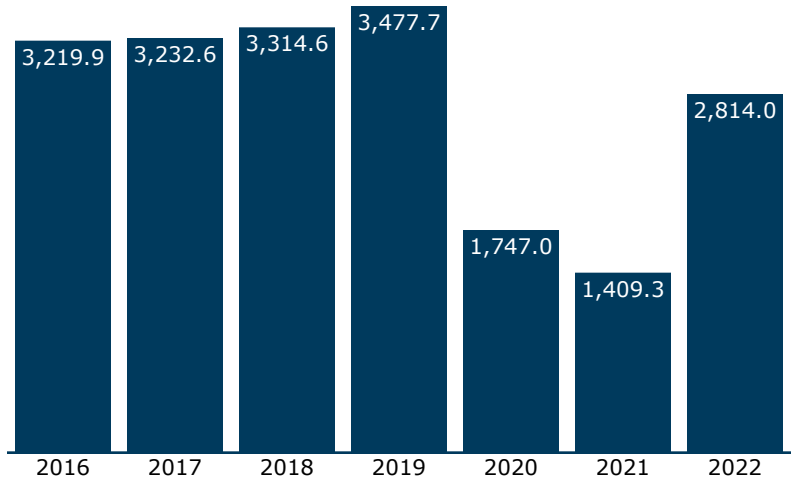


# Fact sheet: Amtrak in Massachusetts
