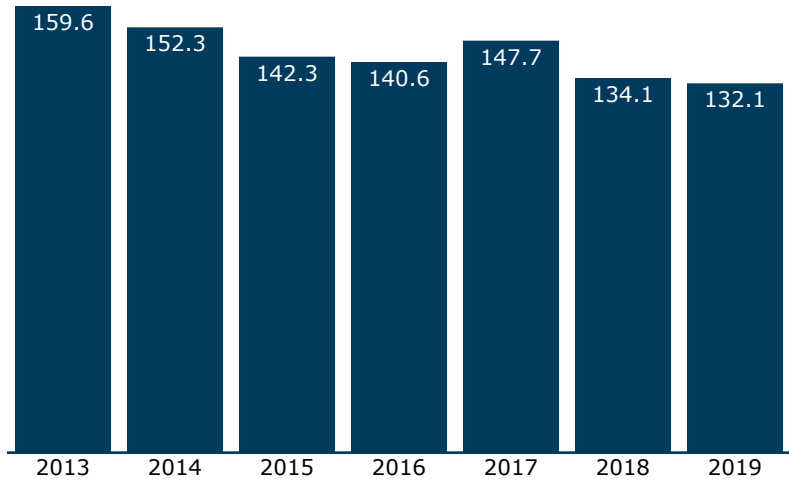


Fact sheet: Amtrak in Ohio
