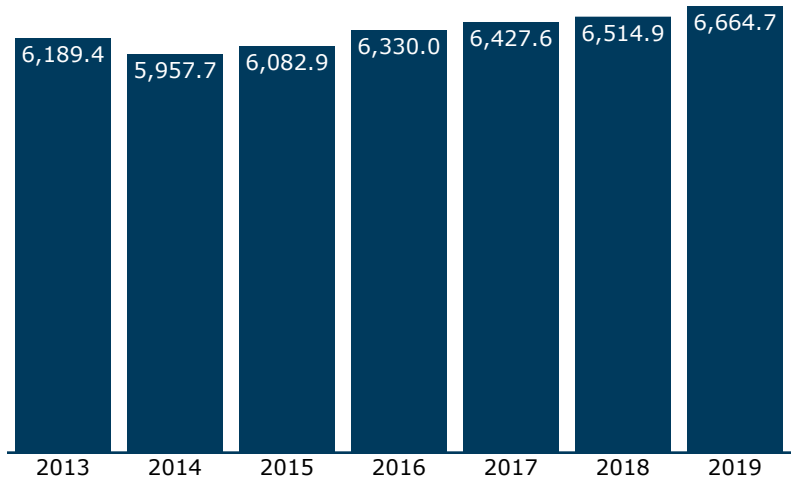


Fact sheet: Amtrak in Pennsylvania
