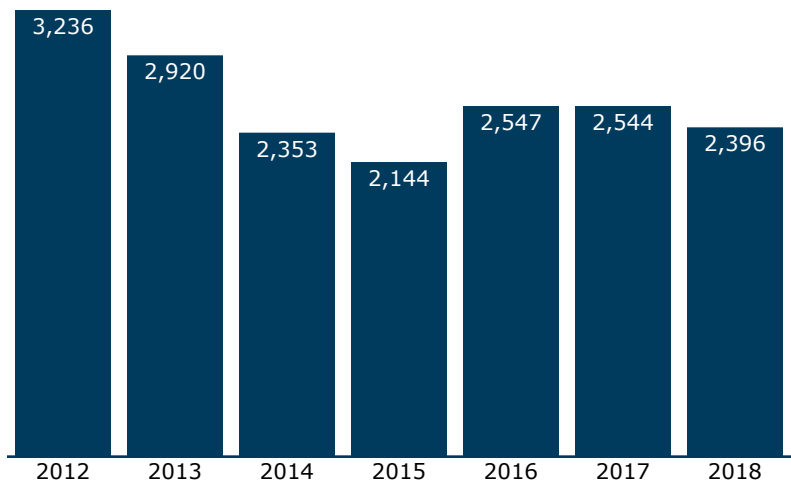


## Passengers using this station, 2012-2018

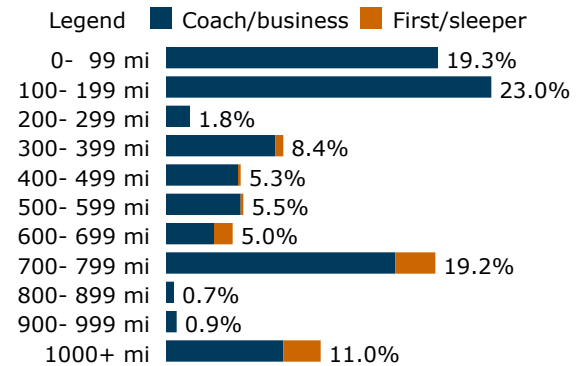
