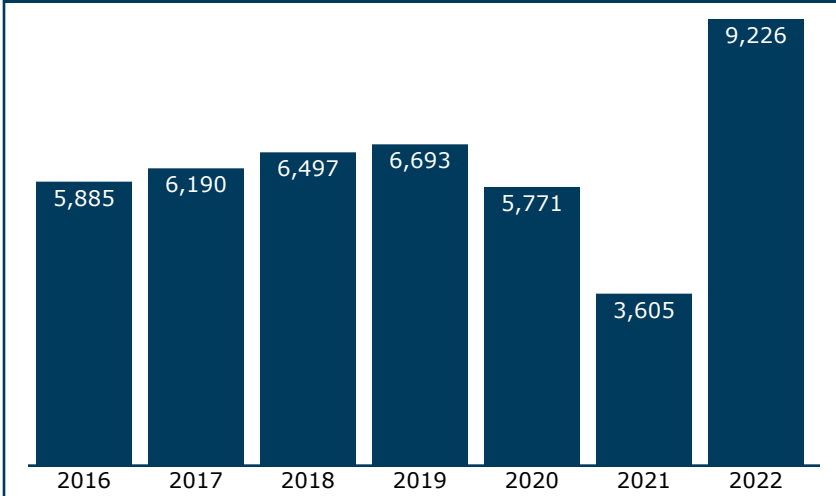


## Passengers using this station, 2016-2022 (arrivals and departures)

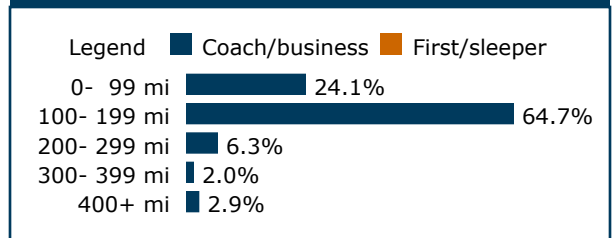
